## About the A13 campaign

We are aiming to raise public awareness of additional enforcement taking place on the A13. Essex Police will be using resources including marked and unmarked vehicles and the force helicopter along the whole stretch of the A13.

This enforcement will address the particular driver and rider behaviours that are causing the large number of collisions and casualties on this busy route.

Statistics show that the majority of collisions involve:

- **Young drivers aged 17 – 20 years**
- **Drivers/Riders aged 21 – 25 years**
- **Drivers/Riders aged 36 – 40 years**

The most common causes in these collisions are:

- **Failing to judge the speed of other vehicles**
- **Failing to look properly**
- **Loss of control**
- **Careless or reckless driving**
- **Being in a hurry or in a rush**



## Helicopter detection

Distinctive helicopter signs are being placed along the A13. They are designed to warn motorists of the possibility of detection of offences by air.
