



# THE LAW IS CHANGING!

From 18th September 2006 you **must** use the correct car seat/restraint for your child



Now children under 3 years in both front and rear of cars, vans and some goods vehicles **must** use an appropriate car seat/restraint.



Now Rear facing seats/restraints **must not** be used in the front seat of a vehicle with an airbag unless the airbag is de-activated



Now children under 135cm tall and from 3 years to 12 years **must** use an appropriate booster seat or booster cushion.

The penalties for not using seat belts or child restraints remain at £30 fixed penalty or a maximum fine of £500 if a case goes to court.
